Below you will find some tips that will guide you into better classroom management

- When the students are rotating stations during Lesson 1-4. Make sure they switch to the same color at the next station. So, if a student is in the blue hoop when they go to the next station they will go to the blue hoop
- You can add clubs to one station at a time. Please go with your comfort level
- If a student is not in the loop that means that too many kids will be moving. Tell the kids that if you(teacher) can stand in the hoop that means they are not where they are supposed to be. To be able to play again, they need to do some type of fitness to get to play again.
- Divide the gym into fourths. If a ball goes into another area, please ask the group in that area to toss the ball back to you
- Use poly spots instead of the tee mats when putting
- Lessons can be done in any order
- If you are incorporating golf into your striking unit and you just finished baseball. Lesson Plan 5 is great transition between the 2 sports

Maintenance of the equipment

- Put rubber tees back in plastic container or put clothes pin in the tee to keep it round for the kids to tee the ball up easier
- Use lint roller to clean the velcro targets or use a little laundry detergent and a brush to clean it up
